Bull Frog Catcher



Instructions

- Squash the bottom of your cardboard tube and cut off about 6cm.
- 2. Paint the inside of the tube pink and let dry.
- 3. Measure and cut rectangles to fit around your tube from one of the sheets of green card. Decorate by gluing on spots of your contrasting green card. Once dry, glue the coloured card to your cardboard tube.
- 4. Cut out frog arms and legs from the card. Attach arm and leg pieces and googly eyes with glue, let dry.


- Cardboard tube
- Scissors
- Pink paint
- Dark green card
- Light green card
- Silver card
- 30cm length string
- Bottle top or button
- 2x googly eyes
- PVA Glue
- Hammer
- Nail

Bull Frog Catcher Cont.

- 5. Cut a 30cm length of string and attach to inside bottom edge of tube with glue.
- 6. Staple bottom edge of tube with 3-4 staples.
- 7. Cut out wing shapes from your silver card and attach along with small google eyes to the bottle top/button with glue.
- 8. Make a hole in the bottle top by hammering a nail through it and thread string through hole, tie a knot in the back to secure.
- 9. Once complete, your kids will have hours of fun swinging the Fly into the Frog's mouth!
