Paper Bowl



Instructions

- 1- Start by covering your bowl with a plastic bag. This bag can be reused time and time again for multiple bowls.
- 2- Place a piece of paper onto your bowl mold and then coat in glue. Continue this over and over.
- 3- Remember to cover the entire bowl and dont worry to much about the edges as they will get trimmed. Once you are happy with your bowl and you have at least five layers of paper then leave it to dry.
- 4- Take out your bowl and remove the plastic bag. This is where you can trim up any edges you want, alternatively you can fold over the edges and glue down. Once you have done this turn, over the bowl and coat the entire underside with glue. Your bag is a great place to sit it on while you leave it to dry.

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- Paper scraps
- PVA (watered down slightly)
- Brush
- Bowl
- A recycled plastic bag or cling film
- Scissors
