

Summer Pencil Holders

Strawberry

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 tin can (clean and dried *Note it may have sharp edges that need to be sanded off)
- Double sided tape or hot glue
- Red (A4), green, black and white card
- Black permanent marker
- Scissors



Instructions

- 1- Take a piece of A4 red card and cut length ways. If you are using a larger tin adapt accordingly.
- 2- Cut out two white circles and two slightly smaller black circles. Layer these circles to make the eyes (see above). Use the black marker to create a small mouth and to draw the seeds (see image)
- 3- Cut three green leaves and tape or glue them to the top (open end of the can)
- 4- Wrap the red card around the tin can and glue or tape at the back.

Summer Pencil Holders

Pineapple

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 tin can (clean and dried *Note it may have sharp edges that need to be sanded off)
- Double sided tape or hot glue
- Yellow (A4), green, black and white card
- Black permanent marker
- Brown coloured pencil
- Scissors



Instructions

- 1- Start the by cutting the yellow card like step one in the Strawberry.
- 2- Use the brown coloured pencil to add a criss cross pattern. Cut out two white circles and two slightly smaller black circles. Layer these circles to make the eyes (see above). Use the black marker to create a small mouth.
- 3- Cut three green leaves and tape or glue them to the top (open end of the can)
- 4- Wrap the yellow card around the tin can and glue or tape at the back.



Summer Pencil Holders

Watermelon

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 tin can (clean and dried *Note it may have sharp edges that need to be sanded off)
- Double sided tape or hot glue
- Red (A4), green (A4), black and white card
- Black permanent marker
- Scissors



Instructions

- 1- Start the by cutting the red card like step one in the Strawberry. Then cut a strip of green card approx 2cm wide and the length of a sheet. Stick to the bottom of the red sheet.
- 2- Cut out two white circles and two slightly smaller black circles. Layer these circles to make the eyes (see above). Use the black marker to create a small mouth and to draw the pips (see image)
- 3- Wrap the red card around the tin can and glue or tape at the back.
